

# The Statistics Software Configuration File

## Overview

The `/etc/stats.conf` file stores the configuration changes that you make in WHM's *Statistics Software Configuration* interface (*WHM >> Home >> Server Configuration >> Statistics Software Configuration*).

**Note:**  
Do **not** edit this file manually.

## File contents

Name	Description	Example
ALLOWALL	This settings allows all users to change their web statics generating software.	no
BLACKHOURS	This setting prevents statistic processing during the specified 24 hour.	10,11
DEFAULTGENS	This setting allows you to set the default statistic generators.	ANALOG,WEBALIZER
allow_awstats_include	This settings allows users to defined AWStats configuration include file.	0

## Example

```
ALLOWALL=no  
BLACKHOURS=10,11  
DEFAULTGENS=ANALOG,WEBALIZER  
allow_awstats_include=0
```
