Overview

You can configure certain portions of cPanel & WHM before you begin your installation.

- [Basic Server Setup](#) — Preconfigure the `/etc/wwacct.conf` file, which contains cPanel & WHM's basic setup instructions.
- [Configuration Settings](#) — Preconfigure the settings that the `/var/cpanel/cpanel.config` file contains. This file controls many of your server's configuration options, and includes most of the settings that display in WHM's [Tweak Settings](#) interface ([Home >> Server Configuration >> Tweak Settings](#)).
- [Release Tiers](#) — Preconfigure your server's release tier, which determines the point in the release process at which you wish to upgrade to new major versions of cPanel & WHM.
- [Yum](#) — Preconfigure your server's yum installation.
- [Apache](#) — Preconfigure your server's Apache installation.
