Overview

To modify the settings for a new account, select the options you wish to apply to the account.

Important:

To access *all* of the options listed below, you must select *Select Options Manually* under the *Package* heading.

Setting list

Option	Description
Dedicated IP	<p>Assigns the new account a static IP address that will <i>not</i> be shared with other accounts unless the user specifies an account for which the IP address should be shared. This option is ideal for resellers.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• After you select the <i>Dedicated IP</i> box, select the IP address from the <i>Select the IP Address</i> menu, or select <i>Auto-Assign</i> to allow the system to assign an IP address automatically.• This list is populated by unreserved IP addresses. You can read more about reserved IP addresses. <p>Note: If you create a package with this option enabled, you will not be able to change this option later.</p>
Shell Access	<p>Allows the user access to the server through the command line interface.</p>
FrontPage Extensions	<p>Allows the user to install FrontPage® extensions to the new account.</p> <p>Warning: We no longer provide FrontPage by default. This option will only be available if you install the Custom Module.</p>
CGI Access	<p>Allows the new account to execute CGI scripts.</p>

Digest Authentication for Web Disk	<p>Enables Digest Authentication support for Web Disk access over a clear text or unencrypted connection. This support is required for users with Windows Vista®, Windows® 7, and Windows® 8 operating systems.</p> <div data-bbox="808 260 1456 407" style="border: 1px solid #f0e68c; padding: 5px;"> <p>Note: This is only required if your server does not have an SSL certificate that is signed by a recognized certificate authority.</p> </div>
cPanel Theme	<p>The theme for the user's cPanel account.</p> <div data-bbox="808 495 1456 619" style="border: 1px solid #f0e68c; padding: 5px;"> <p>Note: You should choose <code>x3</code> for accounts that will host websites, or <code>x3mail</code> for accounts that will only be mail servers.</p> </div>
Locale	<p>Select the new account's language from the <i>Locale</i> menu.</p>
