Overview

This interface allows you to edit feature lists, which you can assign to packages that you apply to cPanel accounts. Feature lists provide or prevent access to specific cPanel features.

Predefined feature lists

cPanel & WHM includes the *default*, *disabled*, and *Mail Only* feature lists by default.

- If you are a reseller who only owns a mail server, use the *Mail Only* feature list.
- If you disable a feature in the *default* feature list, the system disables the feature by default for all of the users on your server. To override this configuration, create a new list and assign it to your users.

If you disable a feature in the *disabled* feature list, the system disables the feature for all of the users on your server. You **cannot** override this feature list with a new list.

Notes:

- To **enable** a feature in the *default* feature list, select the feature's checkbox.
- To **disable** a feature in the *disabled* feature list, select the feature's checkbox.

Create and edit a feature list

To create a new feature list or edit an existing feature list, perform the following steps:

1. Choose one of the following options:
 - To create a new feature list, enter the desired feature list name in the *Add a new feature list* text box and click *Add Feature List*.

Note:

Choose an easy-to-remember name so that you can properly assign it.

- To edit an existing feature list, select the desired feature list from the *Manage feature list* menu and click *Edit*.
2. Select checkboxes to enable features, or deselect checkboxes to disable features.

Note:

To **disable** a feature in the *disabled* feature list, select the feature's checkbox.

3. Click *Save*.

Delete a feature list

To remove an existing feature list, perform the following steps:

1. From the *Manage a feature list* menu, select the feature list to remove.
2. Click *Delete*.

Selectable features

Warnings:

- This table lists the cPanel interfaces for the default cPanel theme (Paper Lantern). If you use the another theme for the cPanel interface, these interfaces and locations may vary slightly.
- Some cPanel features may require that you enable additional settings in order for them to function. Read each feature's documentation for additional information.
- Various settings and customizations can **add** or **remove** features from this interface. You may see additional features that display a *Legacy* label if they correspond to a deprecated theme, or a *Plugin* label, if they correspond to a specific plugin. The following list is **not** canonical for every server.

<i>Addon Domain Manager</i>	Allows the user to manage addon domains.
<i>Advanced DNS Zone Editor</i>	Enables the Advanced Zone Editor interface (<i>Home >> Domains >> Advanced Zone Editor</i>).
<i>Agora Shopping Cart</i>	Enables Agora Shopping Cart .
<i>Analog Stats</i>	Enables the Analog statistics program.
<i>Apache Handlers Manager</i>	Enables the Apache Handlers interface (<i>Home >> Advanced >> Apache Handlers</i>).
<i>Apache SpamAssassin™</i>	Enables the Apache SpamAssassin™ interface (<i>Home >> Email >> Apache SpamAssassin</i>).
<i>Apache SpamAssassin Spam Box</i>	Enables Apache's SpamAssassin's <i>Spam Box</i> feature.
<i>API Shell (for developers)</i>	Enables the API Shell interface (<i>Home >> Advanced >> API Shell</i>).
<i>Autoresponder Manager</i>	Enables the Autoresponders interface (<i>Home >> Email >> Autoresponders</i>).
<i>AutoSSL</i>	Enables AutoSSL functionality.
<i>Awstats Stats</i>	Enables the AWStats statistics program.
<i>Backup Manager</i>	Enables the Backup interface (<i>Home >> Files >> Backup</i>).
<i>Backup Wizard</i>	Enables the Backup Wizard interface (<i>Home >> Files >> Backup Wizard</i>).
<i>Bandwidth Stats</i>	Enables the Bandwidth interface (<i>Home >> Metrics >> Bandwidth</i>).
<i>BoxTrapper Spam Trap</i>	Enables the BoxTrapper interface (<i>Home >> Email >> BoxTrapper</i>).
<i>Change Language</i>	Enables the Change Language interface (<i>Home >> Preferences >> Change Language</i>).
<i>Change Style</i>	Enables the Change Style interface (<i>Home >> Preferences >> Change Style</i>).
<i>Choose Log Programs</i>	Enables the Metrics Editor interface (<i>Home >> Metrics >> Metrics Editor</i>).
<i>cPanel Spotlight</i>	Enables the cPanel interface's feature spotlight. For more information, read our The cPanel Interface documentation.
<i>cPanel Market</i>	Enables cPanel Market functionality.

<i>CPU and Concurrent Connection Usage</i>	<p>Enables the <i>Server Load</i> statistic in cPanel's <i>Server Information</i> interface.</p> <div style="border: 1px solid #f0e68c; padding: 5px; margin-top: 10px;"> <p>Note: This feature only exists on servers that run CloudLinux™.</p> </div>
<i>Crontab</i>	Enables the <i>Cron Jobs</i> interface (<i>Home >> Advanced >> Cron Jobs</i>).
<i>CSV Import (Email & Forwarders)</i>	Enables the use of .csv files to import new email addresses or forwarders.
<i>Custom Error Pages</i>	Enables the <i>Error Pages</i> interface (<i>Home >> Advanced >> Error Pages</i>).
<i>Default Address Manager</i>	Enables the <i>Default Address</i> interface (<i>Home >> Email >> Default Address</i>).
<i>Directory Selection Popup</i>	Enables the <i>Directory Selection</i> window when the user opens the <i>File Manager</i> interface (<i>Home >> Files >> File Manager</i>).
<i>Disk Usage Viewer</i>	Enables the <i>Disk Usage</i> interface (<i>Home >> Files >> Disk Usage</i>).
<i>Email Account Manager</i>	Enables the <i>Email Accounts</i> interface (<i>Home >> Email >> Email Accounts</i>).
<i>Email Archiving</i>	Enables the <i>Archive</i> interface (<i>Home >> Email >> Archive</i>).
<i>Email Authentication</i>	Enables the <i>Authentication</i> interface (<i>Home >> Email >> Authentication</i>).
<i>Email Delivery Route</i>	This feature is deprecated .
<i>Email Domain Forwarding</i>	Enables the <i>Forward All Email for a Domain</i> setting in the <i>Forwarders</i> interface (<i>Home >> Email >> Forwarders</i>).
<i>Email Filtering Manager</i>	Enables the <i>Email Filters</i> interface (<i>Home >> Email >> Email Filters</i>).
<i>Email Greylisting</i>	Enables the <i>Configure Greylisting</i> interface (<i>Home >> Email >> Configure Greylisting</i>).
<i>Email Trace</i>	Enables the <i>Track Delivery</i> interface (<i>Home >> Email >> Track Delivery</i>).
<i>Error Log</i>	Enables the <i>Errors</i> interface (<i>Home >> Metrics >> Errors</i>).
<i>File Manager</i>	Enables the <i>File Manager</i> interface (<i>Home >> Files >> File Manager</i>).
<i>Forwarder Manager</i>	Enables the <i>Forwarders</i> interface (<i>Home >> Email >> Forwarders</i>).
<i>FTP Account Manager</i>	Enables the <i>FTP Accounts</i> interface (<i>Home >> Files >> FTP Accounts</i>).
<i>FTP Settings</i>	Allows the user to manage FTP settings.
<i>Getting Started Wizard</i>	<p>Enables the deprecated x3 theme's <i>Getting Started Wizard</i> interface.</p> <div style="border: 1px solid #f0e68c; padding: 5px; margin-top: 10px;"> <p>Note: This interface does not exist in the default cPanel theme.</p> </div>
<i>Hotlink Protection</i>	Enables the <i>Hotlink Protection</i> interface (<i>Home >> Security >> Hotlink Protection</i>).
<i>Image Manager</i>	Enables the <i>Images</i> interface (<i>Home >> Files >> Images</i>).
<i>Index Manager</i>	Enables the <i>Indexes</i> interface (<i>Home >> Advanced >> Indexes</i>).

<i>Install Perl Modules</i>	Allows the user to install Perl modules from the Site Software interface (Home >> Software >> Site Software).
<i>Install PHP Pear Modules</i>	Allows the user to install PHP PEAR modules from the Site Software interface (Home >> Software >> Site Software).
<i>Install Ruby Modules</i>	Allows the user to install Ruby on Rails modules from the Site Software interface (Home >> Software >> Site Software).
<i>IP Deny Manager</i>	Enables the IP Blocker interface (Home >> Security >> IP Blocker).
<i>Latest Visitors</i>	Enables the Visitors interface (Home >> Metrics >> Visitors).
<i>Leech Protect (requires Webprotect)</i>	Enables the Leech Protection interface (Home >> Security >> Leech Protection).
<i>Mailman List Manager</i>	Enables the Mailing Lists interface (Home >> Email >> Mailing Lists).
<i>Mime Types Manager</i>	Enables the MIME Types interface (Home >> Advanced >> MIME Types).
<i>ModSecurity™ Domain Manager</i>	Enables the ModSecurity interface (Home >> Security >> ModSecurity).
<i>MultiPHP INI Editor</i>	Enables the MultiPHP INI Editor interface (Home >> Software >> MultiPHP INI Manager). Note: This interface is only available on servers that run EasyApache 4.
<i>MultiPHP Manager</i>	Enables the MultiPHP Manager interface (Home >> Software >> MultiPHP Manager). Note: This interface is only available on servers that run EasyApache 4.
<i>MySQL</i>	Enables MySQL®.
<i>Network Tools</i>	Enables the Track DNS interface (Home >> Advanced >> Track DNS).
<i>Optimize Website</i>	Enables the Optimize Website interface (Home >> Software >> Optimize Website).
<i>Parked Domain Manager</i>	Enables the Aliases interface (Home >> Domains >> Aliases).
<i>Password Change</i>	Enables the Password & Security interface (Home >> Preferences >> Password & Security).
<i>PGP/GPG</i>	Enables PGP and GPG encryption.
<i>PhpMyAdmin</i>	Enables phpMyAdmin.
<i>PhpPgAdmin</i>	Enables phpPgAdmin.
<i>PostgreSQL</i>	Enables PostgreSQL®.
<i>Raw Access Logs</i>	Enables the Raw Access interface (Home >> Metrics >> Raw Access).
<i>Redirect Manager</i>	Enables the Redirects interface (Home >> Domains >> Redirects).
<i>Remote Calendars and Address Books</i>	Enables the Calendars and Contacts interface (Home >> Email >> Calendars and Contacts).
<i>Ruby on Rails</i>	Enables Ruby on Rails®.

See PHP Configuration	Enables the <i>PHP</i> interface (<i>Home >> Software >> PHP</i>).
Server Status Viewer	Enables the <i>Service Information</i> information in cPanel's <i>Server Information</i> interface.
Simple DNS Zone Editor	Enables the <i>Simple Zone Editor</i> interface (<i>Home >> Domains >> Simple Zone Editor</i>).
Site Publisher	Enables the <i>Site Publisher</i> interface (<i>Home >> Domains >> Site Publisher</i>).
Site Software	Enables the <i>Site Software</i> interface (<i>Home >> Software >> Site Software</i>).
SSH Connection Window	Enables the <i>SSH Access</i> interface (<i>Home >> Security >> SSH Access</i>).
SSL Host Installer	Enables SSL certificate installation.
SSL Manager	Enables the <i>SSL/TLS</i> interface (<i>Home >> Security >> SSL/TLS</i>).
SSL/TLS Wizard	Enables the <i>SSL/TLS Wizard</i> interface (<i>Home >> Security >> SSL/TLS Wizard</i>).
Subdomain Manager	Enables the <i>Subdomains</i> interface (<i>Home >> Domains >> Subdomains</i>).
Subdomain Stats	Enables statistics for subdomains.
Theme Switching	Enables the <i>Theme</i> menu in the <i>General Information</i> section of cPanel's <i>Home</i> interface.
Two-Factor Authentication (Google Authenticator)	Enables the <i>Two-Factor Authentication</i> interface (<i>Home >> Security >> Two-Factor Authentication</i>).
Update Notification Preferences	Enables notification preference options in the <i>Contact Information</i> interface (<i>Home >> Preferences >> Contact Information</i>).
Video Tutorials	Enables the x3 theme's <i>Video Tutorials</i> interface (<i>Home >> Preferences >> Video Tutorials</i>). <div style="border: 1px solid #ccc; padding: 5px; margin: 10px 0;"> <p>Note: This interface does not exist in the default cPanel theme.</p> </div>
Virus Scanner	Enables ClamAV virus scans.
Web Disk	Enables the <i>Web Disk</i> interface (<i>Home >> Files >> Web Disk</i>).
Webalizer Stats	Enables the <i>Webalizer</i> statistics program.
Webmail	Enables the <i>Webmail</i> feature in the <i>Email Accounts</i> interface (<i>Home >> Email >> Email Accounts</i>).
Webprotect	Enables the WebProtect application.
WordPress (cPanel)	Enables the cPanel-provided WordPress® installer.
