## Overview

Use the `/usr/local/cpanel/bin/backup` script to run a backup in WHM via the command line.

## Run a manual backup

To run a backup manually, log in to the command line via SSH as the `root` user and run the following command:

```
/usr/local/cpanel/bin/backup
```

## Options

The `/usr/local/cpanel/bin/backup` script accepts the following options:

Option	Description	Example
<code>--force</code>	Performs an additional backup, even if the system already contains up-to-date backup files.	<code>/usr/local/cpanel/bin/backup --force</code>
<code>--debug</code>	Runs the backup in the foreground and prints its progress on the command line.	<code>/usr/local/cpanel/bin/backup --debug</code>
<code>--help</code>	Displays additional information.	<code>/usr/local/cpanel/bin/backup --help</code>

## Create a `cpmove` archive for an account

You can use the `/usr/local/cpanel/scripts/pkgacct` script to create a `cpmove` archive for an account. For more information, read [The `pkgacct` Script](#) documentation.

To use a custom packaging script, perform the following steps:

1. Copy the `/usr/local/cpanel/scripts/pkgacct` file and modify it.
2. Store the modified `pkgacct` file in the `/var/cpanel/lib/Whostmgr/Pkgacct/pkgacct` directory.
3. Run the `/usr/local/cpanel/bin/backup` command with the `--allow-override` flag.
