Overview

This feature allows you to reset a zone file to its default values.

Warnings:

- DNS zones that reside on other *Write-only* DNS servers in a DNS cluster will **not** appear in this interface.
- Exercise caution when you reset a zone file. Inaccurate DNS entries may cause dependent services to fail.

Reset file

To reset a zone file, perform the following steps:

1. Select the domain that corresponds to the zone file that you wish to reset.
2. Click *Reset*. A new interface will appear.
3. Click *Confirm*.
