Overview

This document describes how to list domains with DNS Security Extensions (DNSSEC) on a server.

List domains

To list the domains with DNSSEC on a server, login as to the server as the `root` user via SSH. Then, run the command for your server's cPanel & WHM version.

For cPanel & WHM version 76 and later (PowerDNS 4.1)

```
pdnsutil list-secure-zones
```

cPanel & WHM version 60 through 74 (PowerDNS 3.0 to 4.0)

```
pdnssec list-secure-zones
```

Output

The output for all versions will resemble the following example:

```
Aug 24 12:28:29 [bindbackend] Done parsing domains, 0 rejected, 443 new, 0  
removed  
example.com  
All secure zonecount:1
```

Note:

`example.com` represents a domain on your server.
