

Keyboard Shortcuts in WHM

Overview

We include keyboard shortcuts within the WHM interface to allow for quicker navigation. You can use some of these shortcuts in any part of the WHM interface, while others only apply to the left navigation menu.

Global shortcuts

Key	Action
<i>Shift + 8</i> (Asterisk)	Toggle the menu between <i>Expand all</i> and <i>Collapse all</i> .
<i>Ctrl + /</i>	Move the cursor to the search box. <div>Note: Use <i>Command + /</i> in MacOS®.</div>
<i>`</i> (Backtick)	Hide or show the side navigation menu. <div>Note: We added this functionality in cPanel & WHM version 66.</div>
<i>Alt + F2</i>	Opens the <i>Support Menu</i> tab.

Left navigation menu shortcuts

Key	Action
<i>Up</i>	Navigate up the interface or menu.
<i>Down</i>	Navigate down the interface or menu.
<i>Left</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">For left-to-right (LTR) locales, collapse the highlighted category.For right-to-left (RTL) locales, expand the highlighted category.
<i>Right</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">For left-to-right (LTR) locales, expand the highlighted category.For right-to-left (RTL) locales, collapse the highlighted category.
<i>Enter</i>	Open the selected item.
<i>Shift + Tab</i>	Navigate up the menu.
<i>Tab</i>	Navigate down the menu.
<i>Home</i>	Select the first section in the menu. <div>Note: Use <i>Fn + Left arrow</i> in MacOS.</div>

<i>End</i>	Select the last item in the menu. Note: Use <i>Fn + Right</i> arrow in MacOS.
<i>Esc</i>	Clear the search box.

Set up browser shortcuts in MacOS

Note:

Firefox or Safari® browser users on the MacOS may need to activate the use of the *Tab* key to properly navigate the left menu.

To activate use of the *Tab* key in Firefox, perform the following steps:

1. Open *System Preferences* in your MacOS system.
2. Click *Keyboard*.
3. Select *Keyboard Shortcuts*.
4. Select *All controls* under the *Full Keyboard Access* section.

To activate use of the *Tab* key in Safari, perform the following steps:

1. Open Safari.
2. In the menu bar, click *Safari* and then select *Preferences* from the menu.
3. Select *Advanced* from the *Preferences* window.
4. Select the checkbox next to *Press Tab* to highlight each item on a webpage.
