Overview

You can use the `/scripts/modify_packages` script to set existing packages to use a new cPanel theme.

Note:

To set a new theme for current cPanel accounts, use the `/scripts/modify_accounts` script.

The `/scripts/modify_packages` script

To use this script, run the following command as the `root` user:

```
/scripts/modify_packages --theme=theme_name [options]
```

Notes:

In this example, `theme_name` represents the name of the theme that you wish to set for the package.

Arguments

The `/scripts/modify_package` script accepts the following arguments:

Option	Description	Example
<code>--theme</code>	Required The theme name that you wish to assign to the package. Specify the <code>paper_lantern</code> theme or the name of another valid theme that exists on the server.	<pre>/scripts/modify_packages --theme=paper_lantern</pre>
<code>--packages</code>	A comma-separated list of packages that you wish to modify.	<pre>/scripts/modify_packages --theme=paper_lantern --packages=my_pkg,another_pkg</pre>

<code>--all-packages</code>	Update all of the packages that exist on the server.	<pre>/scripts/modify_packages --theme=paper_1 antern --all-packages</pre>
-----------------------------	--	---
