Overview


The *Password Generator* feature generates secure passwords, which are difficult for malicious users to guess. You can use the *Password Generator* anywhere that the button is available.

When you click the *Password Generator* button, a new window appears that contains a generated password in a text box. Click *Generate Password* as many times as you wish until you are satisfied with the password.

Change password

To set the security requirements of the new password, perform the following steps:

1. Click *Advanced Options*.
2. Enter the desired length of the password in the *Length* text box.
3. Select whether to include uppercase letters, lowercase letters, numbers, or symbols.
4. Copy the password in a safe place and select the *I have copied this password in a safe place* checkbox at the bottom of the window.
5. Click *Use Password* to use the generated password.
 - To reject the password and close the *Password Generator* window, click *Cancel*.
