Overview

The `mcrypt` PHP module provides an interface to the `mcrypt` library and supports encryption. The cPanel-provided EasyApache 4 profiles include the `mcrypt` PHP module by default.

Compatibility

This module possesses no known compatibility issues.

Requirements

This module depends on the `mcrypt` library, which EasyApache 4 installs to the `/opt/cpanel/libmcrypt` directory when you install the `mcrypt` module.

Installation steps

In the interface

To install or uninstall the `mcrypt` PHP module, use WHM's [EasyApache 4](#) interface (*WHM >> Home >> Software >> EasyApache 4*).

On the command line

To install the `mcrypt` PHP module, run the following command on the command line, where `ea-php##` represents the version of PHP for which you wish to install `mcrypt`:

```
yum install ea-php##-php-mcrypt
```

To uninstall the `mcrypt` PHP module, run the following command on the command line, where `ea-php##` represents the version of PHP for which you wish to uninstall `mcrypt`:

```
yum remove ea-php##-php-mcrypt
```
