Overview

This interface displays a table of all of the active processes on your server.

Show Current Running Processes

The table displays the process information in the following five columns:

Column	Description
<i>Pid</i>	The process' ID number. In a *nix system, the system assigns a unique identification number to each process.
<i>Name</i>	The name of the process or daemon.
<i>File</i>	The full path to the file that started the daemon or process.
<i>Current Directory</i>	Specifies the directory in which the process runs. Typically, this is the root (/) directory.
<i>Command Line</i>	Specifies the command or directory that started the process.
