## Overview

This feature allows you to reserve an IP address that is in your address pool.

## Reserve an IP address

When you reserve an IP address, you cannot assign it to newly-created accounts. This is useful if, for example, you do not want the system to automatically assign a specific IP address to a new account as a dedicated IP address.

To reserve an IP address, perform the following steps:

1. Select the checkbox next to the IP address that you wish to reserve.



### Note:

We **strongly** suggest that you specify a reason for why you reserved the IP address. This can be useful if, for example, multiple people administer your server.

2. Click *Save*.

## Unreserve an IP address

To unreserve an IP address, perform the following steps:

1. Deselect the checkbox next to the IP address that you wish to place back in the address pool.
2. Click *Save*.
